

Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 – Last Updated August 27, 2024

The Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 is designed to meet community expectations for more open, accountable and transparent government. The Act requires councils to record and publish information about contracts when entered into with the private sector. A register of government contracts is manadatory open-access information, required under sections 6 and 18 of the GIPA Act. How this information is made available is prescribed in Part 3, Division 5 (sections 27 - 40 inclusive).

The register must be published on Councils website and made public in any other way Council decides.

Class 1 Contracts:

Contracts are those that have, or are likely to have, a value of \$150,000 or more

Requirements for Class 2 and Class 3 Contracts:

Notes: Class 2 and Class 3 contracts are contracts Federation Council is a party to, that have (or likely to have), a value of \$150,000 or more AND to which one of the following applies:

1. there has not been a tender process, the proposed contract has not been made publicly available and the terms and conditions of the contract have been negotiated directly with the contractor;

2. the proposed contract (whether or not made publicly available) has been the subject of a tendering process and the terms and conditions of the contract have been substantially negotiated with the successful tenderer;

3. the obligations to maintain or operate infrastructure or assets could continue for 10 years or more;

4. the contract involves a privately financed project as defined by guidelines published by the Treasury; OR the contract involves a transfer of a significant asset of the agency concerned to another party to the contract in exchange for the transfer of an asset to the agency.

A class 3 contract is a contract of \$5 million or more AND in addition to the above, requires a copy of the contract to be included in the government contracts register.
