

## 2022 COMMUNITY CALENDAR COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Planning is underway for the 2022 Community Calendar, which will capture creating opportunity and celebrating community within the Federation Council area as the key theme.

Council is inviting residents to share the local treasures of their town by submitting photos that depict the community where they live.

Photographs could include a significant natural feature that promotes our Council area, the great clubs and local people, the wide open spaces, historic buildings, wild life, natural or man-made works of art – the options are endless!

Entries are being accepted in the following categories:

1. On the Water.
2. Outdoor Adventure.
3. History, Arts & Culture.
4. Food & Drink.
5. Events & Festivals.
6. Community and Sporting Groups.

A total of twelve photographs will be selected for use in the 2022 Community Calendar and a prize of \$100 per photo selected will be offered.

The winner of the Panel's Choice Award of the Show Us Your Federation Youth Council 2.0 competition will be featured in the 2022 Community Calendar and the photo will be purchased in accordance with this competition.

A complimentary copy of the calendar will be available for residents to collect from any Council office in Corowa, Howlong, Mulwala and Urana. Copies of the calendar will also be made available for purchase from Federation Council offices for \$10 each.

Entries towards the competition will open for three weeks from Thursday 28 October 2021 and close on Friday 19 November 2021.

### Conditions of Competition

- The competition is open to residents who live in the Federation Council area.
- Each individual photo must be accompanied by a completed Entry Form.
- Federation Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in its opinion, includes objectionable content, profanity or potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements.
- Photographs submitted must be the entrants own.
- Winners will be announced during December 2021, prior to publication of the 2022 Calendar.

### Image quality

Images must be:

- High-resolution quality (min 2MB and max 5MB),
- Landscape orientation,
- Provided as a JPG file.

## Permissions

If a person has been included in the image, permission must be given from that person or guardian if under 18 years of age.

Selected photos will be purchased by Federation Council for a set fee of \$100 per image. Federation Council will own the rights to the purchased image and will have the right to use the image for promotional purposes including print, online and media channels.
