Expression of Interest: Event Management - North of the Murray Event Series

Federation Council is seeking expressions of interest from an event manager to plan, promote, and coordinate the North of the Murray Event Series held in Corowa, Howlong, Mulwala, and Urana, in the Federation LGA.

The North of the Murray Event Series is to be conducted by the end of December 2023. The event is being designed to reconnect the community, and further advance the 2023 calendar of events for North of the Murray. Drawing visitors to our 4 central towns of Corowa, Howlong, Mulwala and Urana.

It is anticipated that events will feature live music, market stalls, children's entertainment, food stalls and the possibility to include local community groups, local schools, and attractions.

The key objective is to increase visitation and brand awareness, and grow the visitor economy across North of the Murray, along with supporting Federation's post-disaster communities. Considering the recent impacts of flood events and COVID-19 on the tourism industry, it is critical to support the events sector and create awareness of not only this event, but the North of the Murray brand, and the region, to strengthen demand and rebuild the visitor economy for all stakeholders.

The North of the Murray Series is to be a family-oriented event focused on helping communities and businesses to recover from the impacts of COVID 19 restrictions, border closures and cumulative natural disasters and impacts, including flood events. The event has been funded via the NSW Government Community Event Program, with support from Federation Council.

A response is requested by COB Tuesday 20 June 2023. The response should include a proposed timeline, quotation for the deliverables outlined in the EOI document, and any other relevant information.



General Rates Estimator 2023/2024



Your rates help Council maintain our beautiful region and provide income to run essential community services and infrastructure. They can be paid annually or quarterly.

Federation Council is pleased to provide our residents with the general rates estimator tool from our website.

This tool allows you to receive an estimate of your Council rates for a full financial year, taking into consideration the proposed Special Rate Variation scenario and the Rate Peg only scenario for 2023-2024.

This estimator tool does not reflect additional charges such as utility charges (water & sewer) and waste charges. It is an estimate only and does not include rebates, pensioner concession or other adjustments and is subject to change.

What is being calculated?

There are two amounts calculated:

- The first amount is your General Rates Estimate with the proposed rate peg increase of 4.3%.
 - The second calculation is your General Rates Estimate with the proposed Special Rate Variation increase of 19%.


Expressions of Interest from Aboriginal artists to contribute to Council's forthcoming Reconciliation Action Plan are currently being invited.

Federation Council is excited to announce that students from Miki City, Japan, will be visiting the Federation Council as part of the Sister City Cultural Exchange Program.

The Miki City Federation Council Sister City cultural exchange program is in its 26th year. The program involves students visiting Japan every second year and Japanese students coming to Federation Council on the alternate year.

With the impacts of Covid-19, this year will be the first travel exchange to take place since 2019, with the Federation Council hosting visitors from Miki City during late August 2023. Students and chaperones, as well as dignitaries from Miki City Council will likely attend.

Guests will stay with local host families, to enable them to experience everyday life in an Australian household for up to a week.

Federation Council Mayor Cr Patrick Bourke said, it is a great opportunity for the Federation community to get involved in the sister program by hosting students, chaperones and dignitaries.


Council has compiled a New Resident Kit to provide you with a handy reference guide to the services and facilities available from Council and within the community.
