# **2023 Australia Day Award Nominations**



It's that time of year again – time to start thinking about nominating inspiring individuals for a Federation Council Australia Day Award.

Each year, Federation Council invites nominations for the Australia Day Awards which are presented to local individuals or groups who have made an outstanding contribution to our community at the Official Australia Day Awards Ceremony.

Federation Council Mayor, Councillor Patrick Bourke is encouraging people to start considering that someone who makes a fantastic contribution to the community. "There are many deserving people and community groups in our community who do wonderful things that often go unnoticed," he said.

"This could be a friend, someone at your sports club or community association or someone you know doing great work serving the community." Mayor Bourke said being nominated for an Australian Day Award is a great honour, and it is a wonderful opportunity to appreciate those inspiring people in our community, who make you proud to be an Australian.

"If you know someone worthy of recognition, I encourage you to nominate them today," he said.

The nomination period for the 2023 Australia Day Awards will open on Monday, October 3 and close on Friday, December 2 2022.

The Award categories are:

- Australia Day Citizen of the Year Award presented to the most outstanding citizen for the Federation Council.
- Australia Day Young Citizen Award presented to the most outstanding young citizen for the Federation Council, who must be at least 16 years of age (and no older than 30 years of age) on 26 January 2023.
- Local Achiever Awards.
- Community Group of the Year Award the group, based in the Federation Council area, who has made a significant or beneficial contribution to the community during the past year.

The Awards are provided by Federation Council and decided by Council's Elected Australia Day Awards Panel.

The awards will be announced and presented by the Mayor on Thursday, 26 January 2023, at the Federation Council's official Australia Day Awards in Mulwala.

# **Swooping Season**

Spring often signals the beginning of the breeding season for our native birds, mainly Magpies and Plovers, which subsequently means swooping.

During the nesting season, a Magpie may swoop on people, clacking its beak. While alarming, it is usually an attempt to defend its family so just a warning.

The good news is that a single magpie will swoop for only six weeks until their chicks leave the nest.

Last year, a list of known swooping locations was prepared to help protect you and your family. If you know of a hot spot swooping location in the Federation Council local government area, share the location with us by completing the online form available from Council's website.

Our children are especially vulnerable in a crash if they are not in an approved and correctly fitted child restraint that is appropriate to their age and size.

Federation Council will host a free Child Restraint check day in Howlong and Mulwala on Monday 14 November 2022.

The Howlong session is scheduled 9:30am - 11.00am at the Little Ones Early Learning Centre Car Park and the Mulwala session is scheduled 2pm - 3.30pm at the rear of the Mulwala Council Office and Library.

The purpose of the day is to assist parents and carers to ensure that their children are safe by checking that the restraint being used has been fitted correctly.
