### **TEMPORARY DISRUPTION TO** NORMAL TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

#### SUNDAY 21 JANUARY 2018, COROWA TRIATHLON

Altered traffic conditions will be enforced and will effect:

- · EDWARD STREET, from Sanger Street to Riesling Street,
- · RIESLING STREET, from Edward Street to Short Street, · HENRY STREET, from Short Street to Victoria Street,
- · VICTORIA STREET, from Henry Street to the intersection
- of Honour Avenue.
- · HONOUR AVENUE, at the intersection of Victoria Street and Steel Street.
- · STEEL STREET, from the intersection of Honour Avenue to the intersection of Whitehead Street,
- · WHITEHEAD STREET, from the intersection of Steel Street to the intersection of Bow Street and Redlands Road.
- · REDLANDS ROAD, from the intersection of Whitehead Street and Bow Streets to Hudsons Road,
- · HUDSONS ROAD, from Redlands Road to the turnaround point midway along Hudsons Road

Disruptions to normal traffic conditions may include possible delays due to temporary street closures. This is to allow cyclists competing in the Corowa Triathlon and will occur between the hours of 9:00 am and 11:30 am on Sunday 21 January, 2018.
