TEMPORARY CLOSURE - CROSS STREET RESERVE HOWLONG

The Cross Street Reserve in Howlong was recently returned to public access. The reserve links around to Memorial Park Reserve and provides a recreation space for walking, fishing, bird watching and swimming - see aerial image below.

Unfortunately, since opening the reserve there has been a range of inappropriate uses including firewood collection, camping and off-road driving that may cause damage to the reserve.

As such the reserve has been temporarily closed to allow for control measures to be implemented. The reserve is expected to be re-open for public access in 4 weeks' time.
