BROADLEAF WEED SPRAYING PROGRAM

Council will be undertaking a spraying program to all ovals, parks and open spaces during September and early October 2018 to selectively remove Broadleaf weeds.

This program will occur in September and early October 2018 to improve the turf quality and reduce mowing frequencies.

The herbicide that will be used is Stadium Turf (20 g/l Clopyralid, 15 g/l Diflufenican, 300 g/l MCPA). Please contact Council for further information.
