#### Eco-Tourist Facility Warrawidgee, 803 Spring Drive Corowa Integrated Development

Federation Council being the consent authority has received an application (DA 2018/39) seeking development consent to construct an Eco-tourist Facility on land located at Lot 3 DP 791136, 803 Spring Drive, Corowa.

The development proposed is for an Eco-Tourist Facility and is defined as 'integrated development' under the provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

#### TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE SATURDAY 31 MARCH 2018

Council advises that the following temporary Corowa Street closures will occur from 6:00AM to 4:00PM on Saturday 31 March 2018 for the purpose of the safe conduct of the Australian Billy Cart Championships.

- SANGER STREET, between Isabel Street and the roundabout at the bottom.
- CHURCH STREET, and Sanger Street
- MARY STREET, FULL LENGTH
- RIVER STREET, between Sanger Street and rear of Royal Hotel

Detours will be via adjacent streets via Edward Street, Riesling Street and Isabel Street or via Queen Street and Parliament Street and will be adequately signposted.

Bus passengers please note that the River Street bus stop has been temporarily relocated to Riesling Street whilst the road closure is in place.

### WORKS UPDATE - COROWA

Works for the Betterment Parade, Corowa reconstruction have commenced. These works include drainage, watermain and kerb and gutter installation.

Betterment Parade will be subject to road closures from Bow Street to Whitehead Street and Evelyn Street from 7am to 5pm for a number of weeks with detours in place. The Corowa RSL Park has also been fenced off for public safety during this time, but can still be accessed via a different entry point.

### WORKS UPDATE - HOWLONG

Federation Council will be undertaking road reconstruction and stormwater improvements along Hawkins Street, Howlong between Sturt Street and Hammer Street, including a new hardstand to the frontage of the Howlong Rural Fire Service.

The works will include an eight metre wide sealed road with concrete edge strips to protect road pavement edge and improvements to the current roadside drainage and access to properties. Works will commence early April and conclude approximately late May.
