WATER MAINS CLEANING

In order to ensure the highest quality of water for our community, Federation Council routinely performs watermain cleaning programs. The program is in place to minimize the occurrence of discoloured water and ensure residents receive the freshest water possible by removing accumulated material from the water mains.

Federation Council wishes to advise that it will commence water mains cleaning in Howlong and Mulwala from Monday 30 September.

The air scouring process will take approximately 10 to 14 days to complete and customers will receive a letter informing them of dates and times their water supply will be affected.

During the cleaning process residents may encounter dirty or discoloured water over 7 to 10 days.
