FIREWOOD COLLECTION PERMITS

As the cooler weather approaches, residents in the Federation Council area are reminded that they can apply to obtain an annual permit to collect firewood from road reserves for home heating.

To apply for a permit, residents must complete an application form and show proof that they reside in the Federation Council area

Firewood collection is limited to 1 April – 30 September each

Residents will need to apply for a permit annually for each firewood season.

The permit application fee is \$30.00.
