TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Council advises that the following temporary Corowa road closures will occur from 7:00am to 6:00pm from Wednesday 4 September to Thursday 12 September for the purpose of undertaking drainage works.

SELECTIVE BROADLEAF SPRAYING

Selective broadleaf spraying will occur in September and October 2019. All ovals, parks and open spaces will be sprayed to selectively remove broadleaf weeds. The selective herbicide that will be used is Stadium Turf (20g/l Clopyralid, 15 g/l Diflufenican, 300 g/l MCPA).

This process is to improve turf quality and reduce mowing frequencies.
