Federation Council has received an application from the Rotary Club of Corowa in relation to the NYE Fireworks location. The Rotary Club of Corowa has requested the RSL PARK, John Street, Corowa to be utilised for the NYE Fireworks on 31 December 2018 at 9:30 pm and 12:00 am with set up date for the Fireworks from 27 December 2018 and pack down date as 1 January 2019.

An exclusion zone of 50m will be in place and spectators are to be kept back on the opposite side from the dropping zone at least 25m from the firing zone. Spectators will not be allowed to enter the site with their own fireworks, including sparklers and signage explaining this will be at all entrances. Emergency services will be on site and attend to emergencies as required.
