Federation Council advises that there are significant delays to all applications being lodged for each stage of the development process. Staff shortages, in conjunction with the increasing complexity of the NSW Planning Portal Processes required to be undertaken by Council has seen pre-lodgement assessment times increasing to 6-8 weeks and average determination times taking between 10-12 weeks.

COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM

Round two of the Federation Council 2022 - 2023 Community Grants Program opens on Monday 6 February, with funds available to help local community groups, organisations and clubs to deliver a range of community projects and events.

Council is encouraging not-for-profit groups and organisations to apply for a share in \$60,000 of funding for this year's second round of Community Grants Program.

Eligible applicants can apply under one of three categories:

- Category 1 Seed funding grant; to support the establishment of new initiatives, applicable up to \$3,000 per applicant.
- Category 2 Emerging Grant funding; to support the promotion of emerging projects, applicable up to \$1,500 available per applicant.
- Category 3 Community events grant; to support the strategic development for small to medium events, applicable up to \$1,500

An easy to complete on-line application form will be available from Council's Corporate website from Monday 6 February, 2023. Applications close 5pm, Friday 17 March and further information is available from Council's website.

MELBOURNE STREET PARKING - HAVE YOUR SAY!

Federation Council is currently reviewing parking options on the Western/Commercial side of Melbourne Street, Mulwala between Dunmore Street and Inglis Street.

This review is considering the option of introducing timed

parking to encourage an active turnover of available street parking, thus ensuring customers of each business are able to access the business/es they wish to shop at. As you would be aware, a car park exists at the rear of this commercial strip and we would appreciate it if you could discuss with both your staff and any customers likely to be visiting your business for longer than one hour, to utilise this car park, in the interests of all businesses.

Parking regulations are subject to Council's resources to enforce them and we do have some challenges in that area. Hence, we are looking to partner with local businesses to seek your co-operation to encourage optimum utilisation of available parking at the rear of the business precinct, in conjunction with consideration of timed parking on Melbourne Street.
