DAYSDALE FEDERATION WAY ROAD
CONSTRUCTION

Federation Council wishes to advise the community that construction works have commenced on Federation Way Daysdale from Monday 10 January, 2022.

Extensive road upgrading works are being undertaken immediately south of the Daysdale township.

Motorists are advised that changed traffic conditions will be present throughout the duration of the works.

The significant roadworks will necessitate one lane traffic restrictions at some times, to ensure safe traffic management during the construction.

Sensor activated traffic lights, traffic control, speed reduction and safety barriers will be in place.

Works are expected to be completed by the end of May 2022, depending on weather conditions.
