COROWA VIC TO OPERATE 7 DAYS A WEEK

As part of Council's Visitor Servicing Review, the operating hours of the Corowa Visitor Information Centre (VIC) have expanded from July 2021.

The centre which was previously operated Monday to Friday 9.00am - 4.00pm and Saturday 10am-3pm, will now be open Monday to Friday 9.30am – 4.30pm and Saturday and Sunday 10am-2pm.

The change in operating hours is to meet the guidelines for NSW Accredited Visitor Information Centres (AVIC) accreditation and will result in budget savings due to the change in staff structure and ongoing support from volunteers.

The new service model will ensure visitors have access to Council's tourism team, supported by the many wonderful volunteers seven days a week, all whilst meeting AVIC accreditation requirements.

The AVIC sets a benchmark of industry standard for Visitor Centres, provides resources, reports, statistics and industry news relevant to the operation of visitor information services in NSW. Accreditation provides accredited VIC owners such as Council access to the national brand and signage. state and federal funding opportunities, state tourism projects and marketing campaigns; and inclusion in maps and printed collateral. VIC's also gain entry to a nationwide network of centres and the collaborative opportunities that membership provides. COROWA AQUATIC CENTRE LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAM TO COMMENCE

Young swimmers will have a chance to grow their skills and confidence in the water with a new Learn to Swim Program set to commence at the Corowa Aquatic Centre in August. Federation Council has announced the launch of its new Learn to Swim Program which will see classes offered every week on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays during the school terms.

Lessons will be \$16.00 per lesson, which includes the lesson and entry fee and for those children nominated on a family or child membership, they will be eligible for a discount on their lessons, which are priced at \$14.00.

Enrolments for the Learn to Swim Program are now open, and parents are encouraged to complete the online enrolment form on the Corowa Aquatic Centre website, or alternatively, attend the Corowa Aquatic Centre to complete a paper based form.

Following the enrolment lodgment, a team member of the Corowa Aquatic Centre will be in contact with individual families with children aged over three, to arrange a time to complete a complementary assessment by a qualified swim instructor to determine children's skill level and suitable class allocation.
