2021 BIN COLLECTION CALENDARS

2021 Bin collection calendars for Howlong, Corowa and Mulwala areas are now available for downloading from Council's website. No more guessing about which bins to put out each week as the calendars provide all this information. Helpful bin collection tips:

- Be mindful not to overload the bins – maximum weight is 80kg.
- Place bin close to the kerb with the handle facing toward your property.
- Place your bin out the night before your collection day or by 6am on the morning of collection.
- Keep clear of overhanging branches and power lines.
- Please leave at least one metre between bins and other objects, including fences and vehicles.

Council is currently seeking feedback from the community in relation to the Corowa Aquatic Centre Fees and Charges and Special Rate Variation.

With Council having notified the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) of its intention to apply for a Special Rate Variation (SRV), it is a requirement that Council's Integrated Planning and Reporting documents and any updated associated plans be exhibited and adopted prior to a formal application being submitted. Council intends to lodge their formal application, after seeking feedback from the community in February 2021.
