FOOTPATH REPLACEMENT WORKS

Federation Council wishes to advise that footpath replacement works have commenced in Corowa at the following locations;

- Bow Street from Beaupaires driveway, along front of Corowa Plumbtec & Steel Centre to the first driveway in John Street.
- Bow Street small section in front of Apex clubrooms.
- Corner of Bow Street & Gitchell Streets.
- Bow Street between Betterment Parade & Whitehead Street (south side).
- Redlands Road between Whitehead Street & Vera Street (south side).

Reduced speed limits (to 40kmh) and detours for pedestrians in the work zones will be in place.

Businesses and residents that will be impacted by the works will receive a letter advising of the works.

The work is expected to be completed by Monday 21 December 2020, weather permitting.

WHITTAKER LANE HOWLONG ROAD WORKS

Federation Council wishes to advise that road works have commenced on Whittaker Lane Howlong from Monday 30 November to Friday 4 December 2020, weather permitting. The works will include the application of an Otta Seal to the full 4.3km length of the road at 5 metres wide.

The methodology of this work will include the application of bitumen and then spreading road base over the top embedding the layer into the fresh bitumen, rolled and compacted.

Traffic control will be in place during the works and aftercare signage will be on display following the works.

This work is proudly funded by the Federal and State Governments Fixing Local Roads Grant Program.
