### CHANGE IN WASTE FACILITY OPENING HOURS

Federation Council waste facilities located at Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala will be changing opening hours from Sunday 1 August, 2021.

Council has undertaken a review of the facilities entry data which outlined the patronage peak times and days. In line with this information, Council has made the decision to reduce the opening hours at the facilities by removing the Sunday opening hours, and changing the Friday morning at Corowa to a Tuesday morning to provide a more even allocation of opening hours.
