HAVE YOUR SAY ON COUNCIL'S SPECIAL RATE VARIATION APPLICATION

Submissions have now opened for residents within the Federation Council Local Government Area to have their say on Council's Special Rate Variation application with the determining body - the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART).

Federation Council is one of thirteen councils across NSW that have applied to (IPART) for a special variation to increase income from rates above the rate peg.

The Special Rate Variation proposed for Federation Council is for four years from 2023/24 to 2026/27 at 19%, 17%, 14% and 10%, inclusive of any maximum rate peg amount set by IPART each year. Public submissions will be received by IPART til March 3, 2023.
