LIBRARY STORYTIME

Federation Council invites parents and carers to Storytime sessions at the Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala Libraries.

Storytime is scheduled in Mulwala every fortnight on Wednesday mornings from 10:30am and Corowa and Howlong on Friday mornings from 10:30am. The Corowa session is held weekly and the Howlong session is fortnightly.

Children and their parents/carers can participate in FREE story time sessions that involve sharing stories, rhymes and themed activities. Storytime sessions are suitable for ages 0-5 years and run for 30-45 minutes.

Join in the fun, meet new people, introduce your child to a world of books and lay the foundation for a lifelong love of reading.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, a maximum of 15 people are able to attend and accompanying adults are required to be double vaccinated to attend.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF PET OWNERS

Being a pet owner means there are responsibilities by law that are required to be adhered to.

To ensure the safety of your pet and the community, residents are reminded of some of the responsibilities of pet ownership to ensure your pet lives a full and happy life:

- Registration.
 - Microchipping.
 - Wearing a collar and identification tag with the name of the dog or cat, address or telephone number of the owner when in a public place.
 - If you have moved residences, updating your contact details on your pet registration and microchipping records.
 - When you take your dog to a public place they must be under the owners' effective control. This means on an adequate, leash, chain or cord. If your dog is in an off leash area, it must be under your effective control.
 - Provide a secure home environment so your dog cannot escape.
- Our furry friends are so important in our lives and at Council, there is no better joy for our rangers to be able to return your pet home safely, however, if the above items are not followed we may not know where to return it to.
