### TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - DOCTORS ROAD OAKLANDS

Federation Council wishes to advise that Doctors Road, Oaklands will be temporarily closed to all traffic for the replacement of Doctors Road Bridge, 3.7km North of Clear Hills Road intersection from 1 March to 21 May 2021.

The existing narrow single lane deteriorated timber bridge is being replaced with a new wide, two lane concrete and steel modular bridge. The new bridge on the same alignment as the existing bridge will require the temporary closure of Doctors Road to all traffic.

Alternative detour via Federation Way is suggested.

This project is being funded equally by, Federation Council and the Federal Government's Bridge's Renewal Program.

### FIREWOOD COLLECTION

As the cooler weather approaches, residents in the Federation Council area are reminded that a permit is required to collect firewood from road reserves for home heating.

To apply for an annual permit, complete the online application form available from Council's website.

Council staff will be in contact via phone to complete the application process.

Firewood collection is limited to 1 April – 30 September each year. Residents are required to apply for a permit each firewood season (each year).

The permit application fee for 2021 is \$31.00.

### PORTABLE SPEED BOARD IN HOWLONG

Federation Council's solar powered portable speed board is currently located in Howlong. The board provides real-time feedback to motorists of their vehicle speed and a reminder of the appropriate speed for the road they are travelling on. Speed is the biggest contributing factor to injury and fatality crashes on New South Wales roads with 29% of injury and fatality crashes in the Federation Council area involving speed.
