ROAD CLOSURES - RESCHEDULED DATE

Federation Council will be undertaking road works in Corowa on **Friday 27 January, 2023**, at the following locations;

- Dawe Street, between Katrina Circuit & Gallipoli Street
- Hermitage Drive, between Gallipoli Street and Sauvignon Drive

The above-noted sections of roads will be closed to traffic and no street parking will be permitted whilst the works are in progress.

Traffic controllers will be onsite to assist local residents with access to their properties.

HONOUR AVENUE AND SPRING DRIVE ROAD WORKS

The NSW Government is funding essential works for the heavy patching maintenance program on Honour Avenue and Spring Drive both sides to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road.

Work will start on **Tuesday 31 January, 2023** and take 5 days to complete, weather permitting. Work will be undertaken between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday if needed.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Federation Council advises that there are significant delays to all applications being lodged for each stage of the development process.
