KYFFINS RESERVE ROADWORKS

Federation Council wishes to advise that road works will be commencing in Kyffins Reserve Mulwala on Monday 30 November 2020.

The works will include a 2.16 km upgrade of the roadway along with the construction of a 2 metre shared pathway. The work will start from DC on the Lake entrance and will finish at the Bull Plain Road entrance into Kyffins Reserve. Works are expected to be completed by Thursday 24 December 2020, weather permitting.

This work is proudly funded by the Stronger Communities Grant Program.

FOOTPATH REPLACEMENT WORKS

Federation Council wishes to advise that footpath replacement works are scheduled to commence in Corowa from Monday 30 November 2020 at the following locations;

- Bow Street small section in front of Apex clubrooms.
- Corner of Bow Street & Gitchell Streets.
- Bow Street between Betterment Parade & Whitehead Street (south side).
- Redlands Road between Whitehead Street & Vera Street (south side).

The work is expected to be completed by Monday 21 December 2020, weather permitting.
