## BROADLEAF HERBICIDE APPLICATIONS

Council wishes to advise that broadleaf herbicide applications will occur from mid August to mid October 2020 to all ovals, parks and recreation areas in the Federation Council area to selectively remove broadleaf weeds. The selective herbicide that will be used is Jolt (20g/l Clorpyralid, 15g/l Diflufenican, 300g/l MCPA).

This process is to improve the turf density and quality which will also reduce mowing frequencies.
