RIVERINA ROAD WORKS

Transport for NSW are carrying out safety and efficiency improvements on the Riverina Highway near Balldale, about 15 kilometres north west of Howlong.

This work will improve road safety and reduce future maintenance costs by rebuilding the road surface, widening shoulders, and installing rumble strips and wide centre lines. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm weekdays

and 7am and 1pm Saturdays. Work is expected to be completed by April 2021, weather permitting.

The Benalla to Oaklands rail line which runs across Victoria to New South Wales border is currently operating to transport grain during the harvest season to support local farmers.
