## COUNCIL PRESENTS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Council is pleased to present to the community its Frequently Asked Question (FAQ's) document to provide responses to all questions submitted via our online registration form for the Delivery Program and Budget Roadshow Sessions, as part of the exhibition of the draft 2022/23 integrated planning and reporting documents for 2022/23 and beyond.

Federation Council Mayor, Cr Patrick Bourke said as detailed at the sessions, Council's intent was to collate all questions and provide responses that could be made available to the entire community, including those residents that missed any of our eight Roadshow and Drop-in Sessions.

"Council hopes the information contained in our FAQ's provides clarity and factual information to support our strategic and financial sustainability journey," he said.

"We thank the community for their engagement thus far and look forward with anticipation to further engagement as we

continue our ongoing journey to achieve the visions and outcomes sought by the Community in the Community Strategic Plan 2022-2032 via the many supporting plans and strategies including the Long Term Financial Plan (LTFF). "

Council embarked on its current and ongoing financial sustainability journey over three years ago when CT Management were engaged in mid-2019, to lead in the development of Federation Council's first new Long Term Financial Plan (LTFF). The first version of this plan was adopted in 2020/21 and has been updated each year with a draft exhibited, and also updated at other stages as required through each year, for example to reflect new major grant income being received, including for new or updated projects.

In closing, Mayor Bourke said that Council had some challenges to continue to ensure it remains financial sustainable into the future, but is proud of the way Council has balanced these challenges with delivering so many projects and services valued by the Community. Mayor Bourke said if the SRV is approved as part of the adopted LTFF, combined with ongoing efficiency and savings measures, including services reviews, it will provide an increased investment into the assets from 23/24, and a clear pathway to an operating surplus including depreciation in the year 27/28 and beyond. Planning well for maintenance and operations of our assets was critical. Mayor Bourke said if residents have any further questions, to please contact Council through the various communication channels. See Council's website for more information.

## RESPONSIBILITIES OF PET OWNERS



Whether you consider yourself a dog person or a cat person, we all have a responsibility to our companion animals.

Residents are reminded of the responsibilities of pet owners to ensure the safety of companion animals and the community.

- If your dog is in a public place it must be under the effective control of a competent person by means of an adequate chain, cord or leash. The exceptions to this are; dogs exhibited at a show or engaging in obedience or agility trials or a dog secured in a cage or vehicle or in an approved off leash area.
- If your dog is being exercised in an approved off-leash area it must always be under effective control of a competent person.
- You are not permitted to walk more than four dogs at any one time in an on-leash or off-leash area.
- Just like all breeds of dogs in NSW, greyhounds will still be required to be on a leash while in public at all times.

- A greyhound will still require a muzzle in an off-leash area if it has not undergone an approved retraining program. Greyhounds that have completed this program will continue to wear identifying green collars, or, alternatively the person in charge of the animal can carry a completion card.
- If your dog defecates in a public place it is an offence not to remove the faeces.
- Dogs are prohibited in children's play areas, food preparation/consumption areas, reception areas, public bathing areas, school grounds, child care centres, shopping areas and wildlife protection areas.

## SWOOPING SEASON

Spring often signals the beginning of the breeding season for our native birds, mainly Magpies and Plovers, which subsequently means swooping.

During the nesting season, a Magpie may swoop on people, clacking its beak. While alarming, it is usually an attempt to defend its family so just a warning. The good news is that a single magpie will swoop for only six weeks until their chicks leave the nest.

Last year, a list of known swooping locations was prepared to help protect you and your family. If you know of a hot spot swooping location in the Federation Council local government area, share the location with us by completing the online form available from Council's website.

Members encourage others to view the movie "Everybody's Oma", a true story (filmed by her family) of Hendrika who was diagnosed with Alzheimer's & vascular dementia.

New research is showing that over the last 30 years dementia is actually declining. This is due to the good standard of living we now have, much better health care and more awareness of mind tools (puzzles, etc) that we now use to keep our minds alert. Although, dementia is more common than we realize. A diagnosis is not an end point, but a starting point. By focusing on what is strong, not wrong, we can slow the disease. Also, accepting help early is very productive. Information from Dr Helena Popovic. Many will remember Helena being a guest speaker at a Women's Dinner at Oaklands.

## URANA COMMUNITY RECYCLING CENTRE

Federation Council and the NSW EPA have recently opened two Community Recycling Centres (CRC's) in Corowa and Urana.

Many familiar products you use in your home, car, garage and shed can be hazardous to other people and the environment. Because of this, they cannot be disposed of in your red, yellow or green lidded bins.

These include:

- batteries (household only).
- motor & other oils (5-20 ltrs motor oils and other oils).
- paint.
- smoke detectors.
- fire extinguishers.
- gas bottles.
- fluro lights.

Once you no longer have a use for these products, they become household problem waste. If disposed of incorrectly, or released into the environment, these products can pollute our soil, contaminate our water and even cause physical harm to people and animals.

The good news is you can dispose of them for FREE at the following CRC's. The products are then processed and the reclaimed materials used to make other products.

The Urana CRC is located at the Urana Waste Disposal Centre, Boree Creek Road, Urana.
