OBJECTS AND REFERENCES



Mary Jane Rose
The feature story (or protagonist) of the mural artwork.



White Bellied Sea Eagle
The local Bangerang dialect meaning 'white breasted sea eagle'.
Also a fierce predator and powerful animal, relates well to Mary
Rose herself, as a fierce and independent woman.



Bursaria Spinosa
Used as food, the nectar in the flower can be sucked out and consumed.



Hardenbergia Violacea
The root can be cooked and eaten. During the summer months, the fruit will ripen and can also be eaten. The long stems are used for string and to make baskets. The flowers can work as a mouth wash for ulcers and to treat chest infections.



Background and Symbols used

Blue background with dripping colours running to represent rain and water, and to also match existing colour of wall. The diagonal lines represent the Indigenous symbol for rain (will need to check this). The sun and flowers to represent life and growth, with the small bolt in the corner reprvesents the rain, and is a feature I use in a lot of my work.
