## Wheelie Bin - per 240 litre bin

Small load - up to an average sedan boot or half a small trailer, approximately $0.5 \mathrm{~m}^{3}$.


Medium load - up to approximately $1 \mathrm{~m}^{3}$. This may be a full normal sized single axle trailer body or a full utility tray.


Large load - any volume larger than $1 \mathrm{~m}^{3}$ but less than $1.5 \mathrm{~m}^{3}$. This includes larger trailers.
