

# REVENUE POLICY 2024 – 2025 (incl. Fees and Charges)

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# 1. Rates

General rates in NSW are levied on rateable land under the NSW Local Government Act 1993 and general allowable increases other than approved rate variations, are regulated by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) NSW. IPART determines an annual limit to which a council may raise the total general rates that it collects. This is called the “rate peg”.

## 1.1 Rate peg 2024/25

IPART has issued an information paper notifying that the 2024-25 rate peg for NSW councils ranges from 4.5% to 8.2% (2023-24: 3.7% to 6.8%).

IPART has set the rate peg for the 2024-25 financial year using their new rate peg methodology. The rate peg for the 2024-25 financial year for each council, before applying the population factor, ranges from 4.5% to 5.5%. The rate peg before the population factor (the core rate peg), for each council is based on:

- The Base Cost Change (BCC) for its council group.
- A catch-up adjustment for past changes in the superannuation guarantee rate.
- A separate Emergency Services Levy (ESL) factor to reflect annual changes in council ESL contributions that differ from the changes to the council’s BCC. Council ESL contributions support the work of emergency services (State Emergency Service and Rural Fire Service) in NSW.
- Additionally, some councils will receive a council-specific adjustment in their rate peg for the 2024-25 financial year to reflect the increase in the ESL in the years when increases were not captured by the rate peg because they were subsidised by the NSW Government. IPART intend to phase in the subsidised increases that were previously excluded over several years, and at different rates for different councils, to manage affordability for ratepayers. IPART plan to consult on how best to phase in these increases.

Councils also receive a population factor. The population factor maintains the amount of rates collected per person in areas that have a growing population. The population factor for each council ranges from 0% to 2.7%. In the 2024-25 financial year the population factor includes:

- An annual population factor to adjust for the change in the residential population of a council area (excluding the prison population) from 2020-21 to 2021-22.
- A population true-up based on 2021 Census data.

Each council that receives a population factor will be able to spread the larger increase in general income over a growing number of ratepayers. This helps reduce the impact on existing ratepayers and still provide councils with the increase in income required to fund services to a larger population.

Federation Council was issued with a final rate peg of **4.5%** (4.5% core rate peg + 0.0% population factor).

## 1.2 Special Rate Variation 2023-24

In early 2023, Federation Council applied to IPART for an increase above the rate peg for four years commencing July 2023. This is called a Special Rate Variation (SRV) or a Special Variation (SV) as IPART now refer the process as. Council applied for a cumulative 74.59% SRV over four years (including the particular maximum rate peg set each year for Federation Council) to commence on 1 July 2023 (19% in 2023/24, 17% in 2024/25, 14% in 2025/26 and 10% in 2026/27). In June 2023 IPART granted approval for a temporary Special Rate Variation (SRV) increase of 19% in 2023-24, inclusive of the 4.2% rate peg, and this was applied, and then a **17% increase was approved in 2024-25**.

A temporary increase means that in 2025/26, general rates will revert to the amount that would have been permissible under the rate peg, (4.2% in 23/24 and 4.5% for 24/25). **That is assuming no further SRV application is made or granted, to lock those two temporary increases in, and gain any further increases.**

**It is likely that Council will as per the Planned scenario in the current adopted Long Term Financial Plan, re-apply in 24/25 to lock in those two temporary increases, and gain a further increase to continue to address Councils financial sustainability challenges. This will be subject to further engagement with the community as part of the re-application should Council endorse this.**

## 1.3 Total general rates permissible to be levied in 2024/25

The rate peg or any approved Special Rate Variation is applied to the total rates that Council is permitted to levy on rateable properties in the Council area.

Accordingly,

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Total General rates} &= \text{Total General rates} \quad \times \quad (1 + \text{approved 2024/25} \\ \text{permissible to be} & \quad \text{permissible to be levied} \quad \text{SRV increase)} \\ \text{levied for 2024/25} & \quad \text{for 2023/24} \\ &= \$11,063,000^1 \quad \times \quad (1 + 17\%) \\ &= \$12,943,000 \end{aligned}$$

Based on this, Council may levy up to \$12,943,000 on rateable properties across the Federation Council area.

## 1.4 Federation Council rating structure

Pursuant to section 497 of the Local Government Act, general rates may, at a council's discretion, consist of—

- (a) an ad valorem amount, or
- (b) a base amount to which an ad valorem amount is added.

Federation Council's current rating structure provides a base amount to which an ad valorem amount is added.

The base rate is a set amount that has been applied equally to all rateable properties, regardless of rating category or land value.

The ad valorem is an amount that is calculated based on a property's unimproved land value as determined each 4 years or so, by the NSW Valuer General. Properties that have lower values will pay less ad valorem, and properties with a high value will pay a higher ad valorem amount.

Council has the following three rating categories:

- Farmland
- Residential
- Business

### Farmland

Consistent with the Local Government Act 1993 (section 515), land is to be categorised as **farmland** if it is a parcel of rateable land valued as one assessment and its dominant use is for farming (that is, the business or industry of grazing, animal feedlots, dairying, pig-farming, poultry farming, viticulture, orcharding, bee-keeping, horticulture, vegetable growing, the growing of crops of any kind, forestry or aquaculture within the meaning of the [Fisheries Management Act 1994](#), or any combination of those businesses or industries) which—

- (a) has a significant and substantial commercial purpose or character, and
- (b) is engaged in for the purpose of profit on a continuous or repetitive basis (whether or not a profit is actually made).

Land is not to be categorised as farmland if it is rural residential land.

### Residential

Pursuant to section 516, land is to be categorised as **residential** if it is a parcel of rateable land valued as one assessment and—

- (a) its dominant use is for residential accommodation (otherwise than as a hotel, motel, guest-house, backpacker hostel or nursing home or any other form of residential accommodation (not being a boarding house or a lodging house) prescribed by the regulations), or
- (b) in the case of vacant land, it is zoned or otherwise designated for use under an environmental planning instrument (with or without development consent) for residential purposes, or
- (c) it is rural residential land.

### Business

Pursuant to section 518, land is to be categorised as **business** if it cannot be categorised as farmland, residential or mining. Council does not have a mining category so land is to be categorised as business if it cannot be categorised as farmland or residential.

## 1.5 Rates for each rating category for 2023/24

Rates levied for 2023/24 totalled \$11.1 million as detailed in the following table:

## 1.6 Proposed rates for each rating category for 2024/25

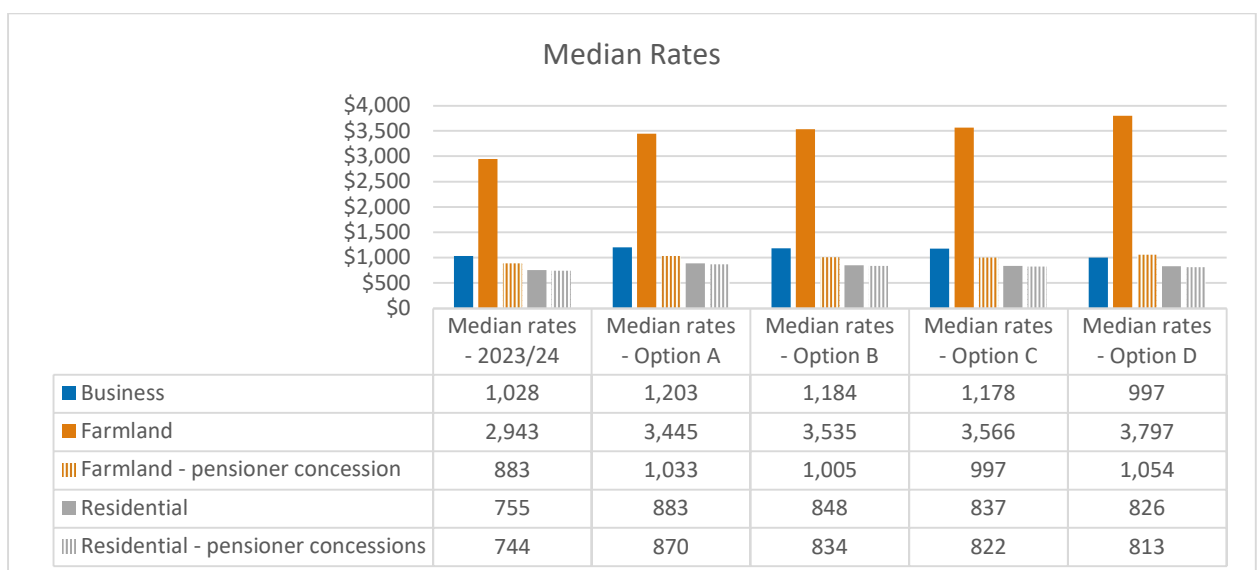
As detailed in section 1.3, Council may levy up to \$12,943,000 on rateable properties across the Federation Council area in 2024/25.

Four options have been developed for levying of general rates for 2024/25. The four options retain the existing rating structure for the Federation Council area with varying base rates.

- A. \$497 base rate (increase of 17%) and amount collected through ad valorem increases 17%
- B. \$443 base rate (rate peg increase of 4.5%) and amount collected through ad valorem increases 23%
- C. \$425 base rate (no increase) and amount collected through ad valorem increases 25%
- D. \$404 base rate (decrease of 10%) and amount collected through ad valorem increases 27%

As the base rate lowers, more rates are required to be levied through the ad valorem amount. This has the effect of increasing the rates on properties with higher values. This is an approach that Council could consider to respond to the current cost of living situation and support more vulnerable ratepayers (capacity to pay).

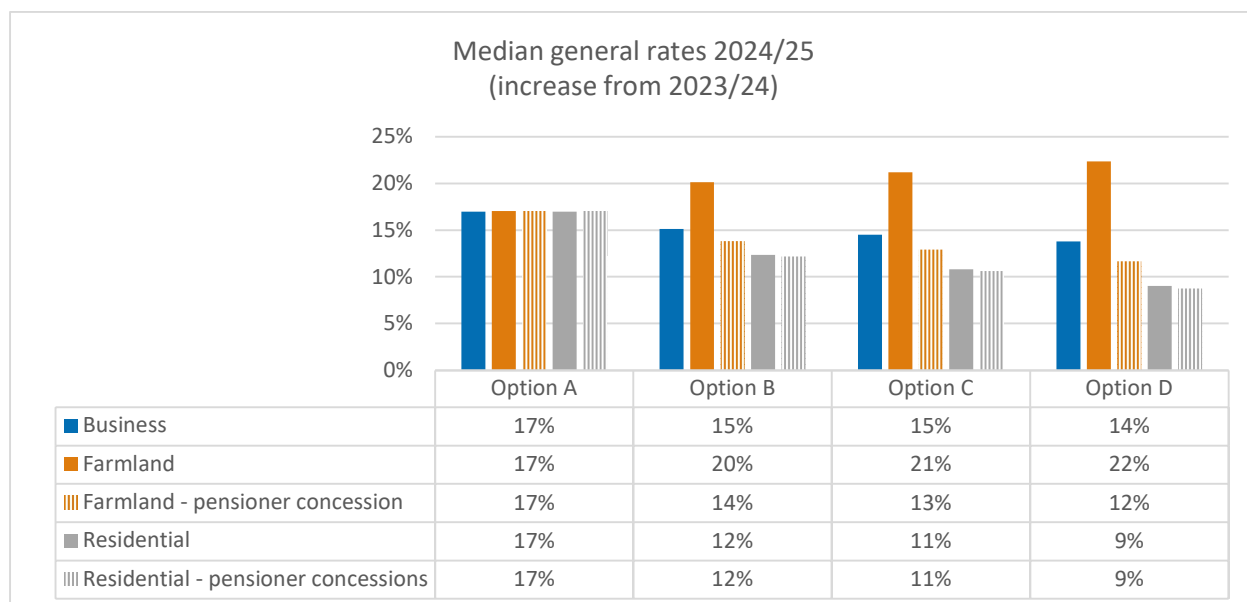
The following graph and table models the 2024/25 median general rates for each rating category for the above four options.



The following graph also provides a summary of the increase to median general rates for 2024/25 (compared to 2023/24) for the four options.

As detailed in the table,

- Option A spreads the impact evenly across each of the rating categories.
- Option D provides residential property owners and pensioner concession holders with the lowest rate increase.
- Options B and C fall between these two options.



### 1.6.1 Option A - \$497 base rate (as modelled in the Delivery Program)

Option A applies the 17% increase evenly with a \$497 base rate (increase of 17%) and amount collected through ad valorem increases 17%.

Under Option A, rates proposed for 2024/25 are detailed in the following table:

### 1.6.2 Option B - \$443 base rate

Option B applies the 4.5% rate peg increase to the base rate, bringing it to \$443 and the balance of the total general rates to be collected through ad valorem increases.

Under Option B, rates proposed for 2024/25 are detailed in the following table:

### 1.6.3 Option C - \$425 base rate

Option C maintains the base rate at \$425 per property assessment and the balance of the total general rates to be collected through ad valorem increases.

Under Option C, rates proposed for 2024/25 are detailed in the following table:

### 1.6.4 Option D - \$404 base rate

Option D reduces the base rate by 10%, bringing it to \$404 and the balance of the total general rates to be collected through ad valorem increases.

Under Option D, rates proposed for 2024/25 are detailed in the following table:

The percentage rate increase, whether by the rate peg or by an IPART approved SRV, does not apply to an individual ratepayers' rates but to Council's general rates income in total as detailed under section 1.3. Individual rates are also affected by other factors, such as land valuations. Therefore, an individual ratepayer's rates may increase by more or less than the percentage rate increase amount.

## 1.7 Ratepayer impact considerations

The IPART decision approving a temporary SRV in June 2023 reminds Council of its obligation to ensure that the impact of rate increases is reasonable, having regard to the current rate levels, the existing ratepayer base and the purpose of any SRV. Brief commentary follows on each of these elements.

### **Current rate levels**

The associated IPART report concludes that at the end of year 2 of the SRV, average residential rates would be 1% less than the average for the OLG Group 11 councils, average business rates would be 30% below the average for comparative councils and average farmland rates would be 30% above the average for comparative councils.

Average rates may not provide the best representation when comparing between council areas.

For example,

- Federation Council has 1,030 farmland properties with a total value of \$3,476,951,470, therefore an average land value of \$3.37 million per property assessment.
- Greater Hume Council has 2,352 farmland properties with a total value of \$2,451,787,820, therefore an average of \$1.04 million per property assessment.

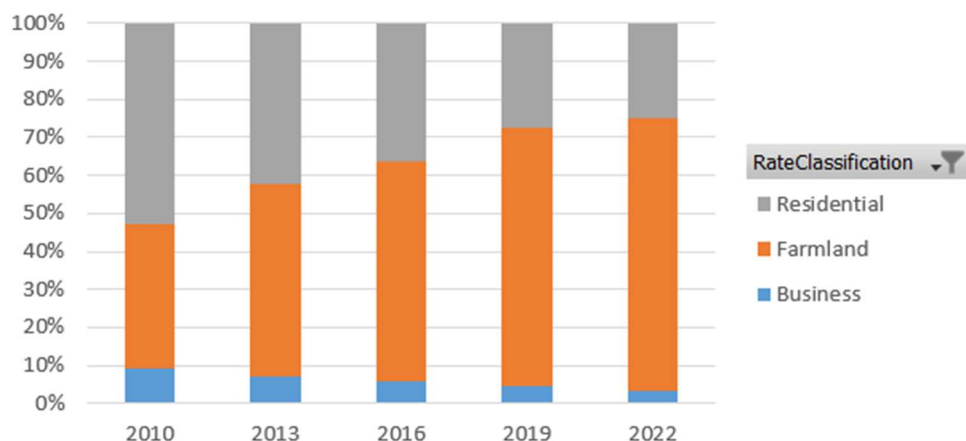
It would be expected that there is a vast difference between the farmland properties, size and agricultural pursuits that results in an average farmland value that is three times that of a neighbouring council area. In addition, this significantly lower land value would be expected to have an average lower general rates level.

Further details on Federation Council average rates compared to the OLG Group 11 councils and neighbouring councils is available in the Delivery Program.

### **Existing ratepayer base – shifts since 2010 in valuations across rate categories**

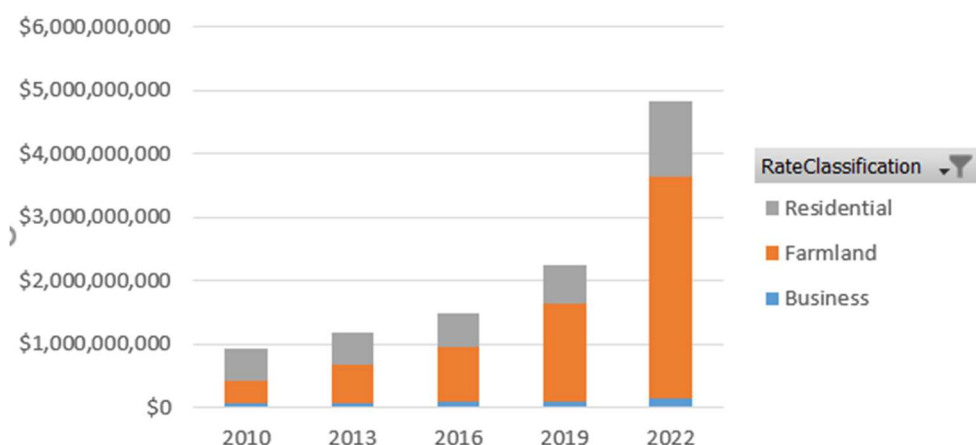
Council's existing ratepayer base comprises three type of property holdings (known as rate categories, being – business, farmland and residential). Over the past 12 years there has been a significant shift in the value of the component categories.

**In 2010, the total value of residential land was greater than the total value of farmland. Residential land made up 53%, and farmland 38%, of the total land value.**



Over subsequent years there has been a significant increase in the value of farmland relative to other categories, with farmland now comprising 72% of the total rateable land value, and residential land reducing to 25%.

The following graph displays the increase in land value over this 12 year period.



The data reports a 992% increase in the value of farmland, a 248% increase in the value of residential land and a 186% increase in the value of business land.

It is noted that since at least 2019/20 (using 2016 valuations) increases to the total general rates to be collected by Council have been applied at each category level, rather than at the total rates level. This has resulted in the proportion of rates paid by a type of ratepayer remaining consistent and this approach was used to minimise fluctuations (increases and decreases) experienced by ratepayers.

Given the increase in the value of farmland properties, this has also resulted in the rate in the dollar paid by farmland property owners decreasing from 59% of the residential rate to 51% of the residential rate in 2023/24.

***Purpose of any SRV***

The SRV approved in June 2023 was to provide additional funds for asset maintenance and renewal, particularly roads, and to address Council’s financial sustainability needs. This benefits all ratepayers and it is difficult to quantify the benefit that each of the ratepayer category receives from such outcomes. Far more extensive community consultation and research is now being undertaken by Council with the assistance from the appointment of the University of Newcastle, led by Professor Joseph Drew, with regards to the reapplication for the future SRV. This will also examine capacity to pay and other factors required to be considered as per the IPART requirements.

## 1.8 Hardship Policy

Council adopted an updated Debt Management and Hardship Policy in November 2022.

Ratepayers experiencing hardship or finding it difficult to pay their rates are encouraged to contact Council. The Policy offers measures that can provide assistance to ratepayers in these circumstances. A copy of the policy is available on Council's website.

Work is continuing as mentioned above with the University of Newcastle led by Professor Joseph Drew to further consider capacity to pay and other options to manage the impact of rate increases on ratepayers and provide advice to Council in making final decisions on apportionment of rates and the quantum of the future SRV

## 2. Water Pricing

Council's water charges are levied in accordance with the NSW State Government Best Practice Pricing Principles. Council does not provide water to the former Urana Shire Council area towns and villages, as this is provided by the Riverina Water County Council.

Separate to the town potable (treated) water schemes for properties in Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala, Council also provides an untreated basic water supply to Balldale, managed under the General fund, and with volunteer assistance, supports a rural scheme for the Daysdale community.

The below information only pertains to the Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala townships.

### **Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala Water Charges (Water fund)**

The 2024-25 water access charges will increase by an average of 10% to work towards addressing the gap in funding the increased cost of service delivery. Over time with further strategic work, Council will align charges with Best Practice Water Supply and Sewerage guidelines of appropriate split between the revenue generated from access charges to consumption charges (recommended 25/75, currently at 23/77).

Commencing 1 July 2023 Council revised the threshold for water consumption charges from 450 kl to 350 kl. Residential water usage charges will be increased to \$2.05 per kl for water consumption up to 350 kl and at \$3.05 per kl thereafter. This is to encourage the more sustainable use of water.

### **Parks and Gardens Water**

Water use for parks and gardens within the towns will be charged at a reduced rate of 80% of the standard fee. This recognises the cost of production and the community benefit derived from such use.

### 3. Sewerage Pricing

#### Residential – Towns (Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala) and Villages (Urana and Oaklands)

The Residential Sewerage Access Charge for towns and villages to be levied at \$897.50 and \$793.80 respectively. As for vacant land sewer charge for towns and villages, they are to be levied at \$510.30 and \$418.00 respectively to provide a concession in that these properties do not create a load on the sewer treatment works or pump stations.

## 4. Waste Management

The Local Government Act 1993 does not allow domestic waste management to be subsidised from the general rate. All costs associated with collection and disposal of domestic waste must be financed from a charge(s) for that purpose:

In accordance with Section 496 of the Local Government Act, 1993, Council determines an annual **Kerbside Waste Charges** (a)(i) and (a)(ii) for the provision of domestic waste management services for each occupied property within the designated waste collection as detailed in the table below, or are located outside the designated area but use the service;

In accordance with Section 496 of the Local Government Act, 1993, Council determines an annual **Domestic Waste Management Charge** (b) of \$61 per annum for each vacant property within the designated waste collection areas;

In accordance with Section 501 of the Local Government Act, 1993, Council determines an annual **Business Kerbside Waste Charges** (c)(i) and (ii) per annum for the waste management services for each property categorised as Business in accordance with Section 493 of the Act and where those properties are located within the designated waste collection;

## 5. Waste Facility/Environmental Levy

Council provides waste facilities in Corowa, Howlong, Oaklands and Urana and a transfer station in Mulwala. There are obligations on Council to rehabilitate landfills when they close. This charge will assist in funding the future decommissioning and rehabilitation of these landfills. A waste management strategy is under development and will guide the future of this charge.

The following charge be levied under Section 501 of the Local Government Act 1993: -

## 6. Onsite Sewerage Annual Management Fee

Council regulates properties with onsite sewerage management systems. This includes maintaining a register, risk rating, inspections and monitoring against performance standards. This management fee will be used to fund the inspection and management program.

The following charge be levied under Section 501 of the Local Government Act 1993: -

## 7. Statement of Borrowings

Provision has been made within the budget for the payment of principal and interest on existing loan borrowings.

No additional borrowings have been included in the ten year outlook.

Strategic work is currently underway to determine future needs of Council's water and sewer services, particularly the renewal of the Corowa Sewage Treatment Plant and the Mulwala Water Treatment Plant. There are some NSW government grant programs, to assist councils in renewing water and sewer infrastructure. Further assessment of future borrowing requirements for the Water and Sewer Funds will be undertaken in the coming years as the strategic work advances.



## 8. Capital Works/Expenditures

Provision has been made within the budget and Long Term Financial Plan for the Capital Works over the ten years. The focus through this period is on asset renewal and required upgrades. Capital works for new assets have not been funded.

The IPART decision for a temporary SRV of 19% in 2023/24 and 17% in 2024/25 provides additional resourcing for capital works in 2024/25.

## 9. Private Works

"The Council may by agreement with the owner or occupier of any private land carry out on the land any kind of work that may lawfully be carried out on the land" (S.67(1)).

Due to the unpredictable nature of costs relating to the supply of materials for Private Works undertakings, it is not possible to develop an accurate schedule of fees and charges that would apply for the coming twelve-month period.

*"Council carries out work for external parties on private land. In performing this work, Council is generating additional income and/or acting in a community service role. Income from these works will cover all incremental direct costs and overheads and where appropriate add a profit element. The profit element of pricing varies with the relevant organisations taking into account the considerations of service to the community and general market competitiveness."*

These private works include:

- Kerb and gutter construction (as per fees and charges),
- Road and associated works contribution,
- Drainage contribution,
- Water supply related works, and
- Sewerage and drainage connection.

Private Work's charges will therefore be calculated on the basis of the cost to Council (inclusive of on-costs)/ normal market values plus a margin of 20% to cover administration and overhead costs. The total calculated cost will be subject to GST at the applicable rate (currently 10%).

It is strongly recommended that a quotation/estimate be obtained from Council prior to requesting/ordering Private Work's undertakings.

*Note: In accordance with Council Private Works Policy, the client is to authorise the work and agree to pay the estimated cost prior to work commencing.*

## 10. Fees, charges and policies (Appendix 1)

(Provided in accordance with Section 404 of the Local Government Act 1993)

The following statement provides details of each fee and charge levied by Federation Council under the provisions of Chapter 15 Part 10 of the Local Government Act 1993. It outlines the nature of each fee or charge and the pricing policy used by Council in setting each fee or charge.

The fees and charges are presented under functional headings as provided by AAS27. Those goods and/or services subjected to GST have been identified in the attached Schedule of Fees and Charges as GST included.

Some goods and/or services supplied by Council have been declared "GST free" or are excluded under Division 81 of the legislation. For goods and/or services, which are "GST free" or excluded from GST no mention of GST appears in the Schedule of Fees and Charges.

### 10.1 Fees and charges highlights

The following are some of the significant changes to the fees and charges:

- Building Certificate Section 6.26 – the associated fee will no longer be regulated from 1 July 2024.
- Non regulated development fees - Council is moving towards full cost recovery model.
- Cemetery fees – State government have introduced a regulated levy on interment services. In addition, over time Council is moving towards full cost recovery model and harmonising fees across the local government area.
- Kerbside waste collection service – the three bin service will be extended to the northern urban areas that were previously recipients of a one bin service. Fees will be harmonised all across Council area.
- Pending the likely adoption of the Independent Review recommendations 1 and 2, relating to better price signals for Councils non-regulated services and moving to cost recovery or where not accepted, showing the merit subsidies, extensive further work will occur to guide future fees and charges in non-regulated areas.
- Some charges are set by the NSW State Government (Development Application fees for example) and have not had any increases for years.
