Participants of the program will work with Murray Arts in the lead up to the LIMELIGHT 3.0 Festival which will be held during NSW Youth Week in Corowa's Bangerang Park precinct on the **Thursday, 18 April**.

A free assorted jumbo drink tumbler and a huge variety of stickers are included in the workshop, so participants can decorate to their heart's content. Participants are able to bring in their own items from home as well to sticker-bomb such as skateboards, helmets, electronic devices or drink bottles. A light lunch is also included.
