REDLANDS ROAD SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) has implemented a reduction in the speed limit on a section of Redlands Road in Corowa, effective from Tuesday 29 April. The speed limit has been lowered from 80 km/h to 60 km/h between 130 metres west of Jasmin Court and the 100 km/h change point, 1160 metres west of Cemetery

Motorists are advised that signage will be installed in the coming days to indicate the new speed limit. Additionally, road markings and a VMS board will be used to alert motorists of the upcoming change.

We ask you for your cooperation as Council officers concentrate on clearing the backlog of applications while maintaining all other legislated services.
