#### **COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM**

Round two of the Federation Council 2023 - 2024 Community Grants Program is now open with funds available to help local community groups, organisations and clubs to deliver a range of community projects and events.

Council is encouraging not-for-profit groups and organizations to apply for a share in \$30,000 of funding for this year's second round of Community Grants Program.

Eligible applicants can apply under one of three categories:

- Category 1 Seed funding grant; to support the establishment of new initiatives, applicable up to \$3,000 per applicant.
- Category 2 Emerging Grant funding; to support the promotion of emerging projects, applicable up to \$1,500 available per applicant.
- Category 3 Community events grant; to support the strategic development for small to medium events, applicable up to \$1,500 per applicant.

## CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON MULWALA BRIDGE

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions on Mulwala Bridge over the Murray River for maintenance work to be carried out.

Transport for NSW is undertaking work under the bridge from a barge and will involve installing steel plates underneath the bridge supports. Work will be carried out between 7am and 5pm weekdays to mid-April, causing minimal impacts to traffic.

As work progresses, a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place across the bridge, 24 hours a day, and is expected to come into effect from February.

Motorists are advised to allow an additional five minutes of travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

The car park on the NSW side of the bridge will be closed during this period while the area is used as a site compound.
