Contract Register



Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 - Last Updated Dec 18, 2023

The **Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009** is designed to meet community expectations for more open, accountable and transparent government. The Act requires councils to record and publish information about contracts when entered into with the private sector. A register of government contracts is mandatory open-access information, required under sections 6 and 18 of the GIPA Act. How this information is made available is prescribed in Part 3, Division 5 (sections 27 - 40 inclusive). The register must be published on Councils website and made public in any other way Council decides.

Class 1 Contracts:

Contracts are those that have, or are likely to have, a value of \$150,000 or more

Requirements for Class 2 and Class 3 Contracts:

Notes: Class 2 and Class 3 contracts are contracts Federation Council is a party to, that have (or likely to have), a value of \$150,000 or more AND to which one of the following applies:

1. there has not been a tender process, the proposed contract has not been made publicly available and the terms and conditions of the contract have been negotiated directly with the contractor;

2. the proposed contract (whether or not made publicly available) has been the subject of a tendering process and the terms and conditions of the contract have been substantially negotiated with the successful tenderer;

3. the obligations to maintain or operate infrastructure or assets could continue for 10 years or more;

4. the contract involves a privately financed project as defined by guidelines published by the Treasury; OR the contract involves a transfer of a significant asset of the agency concerned to another party to the contract in exchange for the transfer of an asset to the agency.

A class 3 contract is a contract of \$5 million or more AND in addition to the above, requires a copy of the contract to be included in the government contracts register.
